

**NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF
 “STAGE 2 WATER SHORTAGE” OF DROUGHT CONTINGENCY PLAN
 AND INITIATION OF “STAGE 1 WATER SHORTAGE” OF SUCH PLAN
 AND RESPONSE MEASURES**

Initiation of Stage. On October 19, 2023, Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 191 (“District”) terminated “STAGE 2 WATER SHORTAGE” of its Drought Contingency Plan and initiated “STAGE 1 WATER SHORTAGE” of such Plan, both because of a notice from the District’s primary water supplier, the North Harris County Regional Water Authority (“Authority”). STAGE 1 WATER SHORTAGE continues until terminated by notice from the Authority to the District that the requirements for water restrictions are no longer necessary.

Customers Affected. STAGE 1 WATER SHORTAGE and the response measures listed below apply to all customers served by the District. The District is located in Northwest Harris County, Texas near FM 1960 W, SH 249 and Cutten Road, and it serves customers in Champions MPC, Champions Park North, Highland Timbers, Champions Arbor, Prestonwood Park and other areas (including areas outside the District’s boundaries south of FM 1960 W and west of Cutten Road).

Response Measures. Response measures apply during STAGE 1 WATER SHORTAGE as follows:

1. *Leaks, conservation measures, etc.* All Customers are requested to: (a) check for, and repair, all leaks, dripping faucets, and running toilets, and (b) utilize water conservation measures such as displacement bags, low-flow shower heads and leak detection tablets.
2. *Irrigation.* Customers are requested to limit irrigation to allowable time periods (7:00 PM on an allowable day to 5:00 AM the following morning) on two designated days per week. The designated days and allowable time periods depend upon the customer’s type and street address, as follows:


Customer type	Customer street address numbers	Allowable days and time periods for irrigation
Single-family residential customers	with even-numbered street addresses	From 7:00 PM on a Sunday to 5:00 AM the following morning From 7:00 PM on a Thursday to 5:00 AM the following morning
	with odd-numbered street addresses	From 7:00 PM on a Wednesday to 5:00 AM the following morning From 7:00 PM on a Saturday to 5:00 AM the following morning
All other customers, including commercial, multi-family, institutional, governmental, etc.	(all addresses)	From 7:00 PM on a Tuesday to 5:00 AM the following morning From 7:00 PM on a Friday to 5:00 AM the following morning

(Note: there are no allowable watering periods starting on **Monday**)

3. *Other measures.* Customers are advised that mandatory measures may be imposed if the water shortage period continues.
